Every autumn, Paris stages Nuit Blanche ("White Night"), a one-night festival celebrating contemporary art. Kyoto, a sister city of Paris, holds the companion event "Nuit Blanche Kyoto" in various locations around the city. The Kyoto edition is a "O matsuri" dedicated to contemporary creation and focuses on Japanese and French emerging artists introduced to a wide audience along a journey into Kyoto heritage venues and art spots.

2018 marks the 60th anniversary of Paris and Kyoto's a friendship covenant, the 160th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between France and Japan, and of 100 years after Debussy's Death.

In Kyoto Concert Hall, you can enjoy Gamelan Music by which Debussy, France's greatest composer, was deeply influenced.
